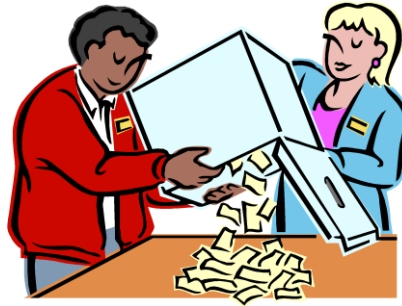


The Village Condominiums Owners' Association, Inc.

2020 ELECTION RESULTS



CC&R Assessment Amendment Proposal: Approval of the CC&R Assessment Amendment required the affirmative votes of at least 165 of the 323 Members of the Association. The proposed CC&R Assessment Amendment Proposal did not pass with 133 “yes” votes and 75 “no” votes.

Annual Meeting of the Members: The Village Condominiums Owners' Association, Inc. held their Annual Meeting of the Members on Wednesday, October 28, 2020. As required by state statute, the election results, including the vote totals for each candidate nominated for the Board of Directors, are listed below in alphabetical order:

Per the Association's restated Bylaws dated October 23, 2019, Article 5: Election of Directors, 5.1: In the fiscal year beginning in 2020, five (5) Directors must be elected and the three (3) Directors elected receiving the highest number of votes will serve two-year terms and the two (2) Directors elected receiving the lowest number of votes will serve one-year terms.

Accordingly, Barry Chandler, James Coleman and Greg Rosicky were elected to serve two-year terms. Janet Ritterspach and Ismael Haluk Soydan were elected to serve a one-year term.

The five (5) Board members for 2020 will be:

The Tax Resolution passed with 155 “yes” votes, 13 “no” votes and 5 “abstain” votes.
