

Dear Village Residents:

The Association needs your help!

Last month, the Village COA used 706 CCF's of water. 1 CCF = 748 gallons of water which means that the community used 528,088 gallons of water within one month. There are 324 units (some of which are vacant) which works out to 1,629 gallons per unit. The equivalent of 326 five-gallon water bottles used per unit each month! Shocking right! Please also keep in mind that these numbers are for our residential meters only, it does not include our irrigation usage.

We can do better! We all know that water is essential to our everyday lives and our supplies are limited; so please, use water wisely. Cutting water use inside and outside our homes is extremely important. If each of us changed our water-usage habits, we could save billions of gallons of water. Here are some tips on how you can help:

What you can do:

- Wash only full loads of laundry and dishes
- Fix household leaks promptly
- Spend only 5 minutes in the shower
- Turn off the water while you brush your teeth
- Buy water-saving devices such as high-efficiency dish washer, toilets, shower heads, etc.

How much you can save:

Saves up to 50 gallons/ week
Saves up to 20 gallons/ week
Saves up to 8 gallons/week
Saves up to 2.5 gallons/ min.
Saves many gallons per day

The maintenance staff is here to help you. If you have a leak in your unit, please report it to the on-site manager right away. If you purchase a low flow shower head or sink aerators, we will install it for you at no cost. Rebates are available for water saving toilets. If you have an old water wasting toilet let us know and we will assist you in installing a new one. We are mandated to cut our usage by 20% so we all need to work together.
